

Consider things like their interests, level of understanding of the topic, and their attitudes and beliefs. The gig economy is tearing families apart. If it is useful for your students to recap their knowledge of persuasive writing techniques, give them the handout Persuasive Techniques Word Match. As a class, brainstorm two lists: one outlining the positives of the gig economy and another outlining the negatives. Then, give students an opportunity to redraft their work, taking on board the suggested improvements. Proofreading & Editing Proofreading and editing your professional communications is crucial to maximizing their persuasiveness. Simple language can be more impactful and memorable, which, in turn, makes it more persuasive. Include an anecdote to hold your reader's attention and connect to them. If your writing contains grammar and punctuation errors, you could be dismissed as unprofessional, incompetent, and inattentive, which would hinder your ability to sell your product or idea. Get this resource here. Encourage teenagers to do what they do best: complain - albeit in the form of a sophisticated, engaging, witty and highly persuasive protest worthy of a grade 9. For example, if you're putting together an advertising campaign for the general public, you probably want to avoid using an overly formal tone or technical terminology. Choose keywords or phrases that relate to your main message and strategically repeat them so the reader is consistently reminded of it. Start with a Hook Even if you're offering great content, without grabbing your reader's attention from the start, they're unlikely to want to continue listening. Read Two Articles on the Gig Economy Give students a copy of the reading Perspectives on the Gig Economy and read them as a class or in groups, choosing a read aloud strategy. If your students need help, possible positives include flexibility in choosing working hours, freedom to control where one works, the ability to work in a variety of jobs. Encourage your students to look for ideas in the two gig economy articles, but also explain to them that when they are filling in their ideas, providing their ideas are realistic and relevant to the central argument of the letter. If helpful, you can give your students the following claims or brainstorm potential claims as a class on the board: For The gig economy will be bad for business in the long run. Keep your language simple and concise so your writing is accessible. Start with a hook to grab your reader's attention.
